Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b), to modify the job definition of the Corrosion Mechanic headquartered in Eureka, Humboldt Division, Redwood Region. The current incumbent is Mr. T.B. Balichik with 23 years of service.

The modification would permit Mr. Balichik to perform mark and locate duties which are normally assigned to a Fieldman. Company will continue using Fieldman to perform these duties but in certain situations, such as staffing shortages caused by sick leave, vacations/holidays and backlogs caused by inclement weather, the Corrosion Mechanic could provide the necessary relief.

Agreement reached on this proposal would serve to fill our Mr. Balichik's workload as the volume of corrosion work has been declining. If implemented, Company will insure that the number of Fieldman classifications in Eureka will not be reduced as a result of this agreement. Mr. Balichik is the only Corrosion Mechanic in Humboldt Division. There are currently six Fieldman classifications in Eureka.


