Gentlemen:

Company proposes the relocation of a vacant telecommunications technician floor number from the Oakland office at 1919 Webster Street to a newly established telecommunications headquarters in Livermore. The position at 1919 Webster Street was moved on May 15, 1989, shortly after the parties entered into letter of agreement 88-104 which required we maintain the compliment of physical classifications which then existed at each headquarters. This position was relocated to Oakport, however, the floor numbers for 88-104 reporting purposes still indicates there should be a telecommunications technician position at the Oakland location. In fact, General Services has no intention of ever maintaining a position at 1919 Webster Street.

Due to the increasing telecommunication workload along the Interstate 680 corridor (i.e. Learning Center, D.E.R., etc.) Company proposes to establish a new telecommunications headquarters in Livermore. In conjunction with the establishment of this new office, Company proposes to transfer this floor number from Oak-
