Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 202.16 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to establish a temporary 4-day, 10-hour workweek for the Stockton Electric Meter Department. This request will encompass the five Senior Metermen and one Unassigned Senior Meterman. The Service Meterman and Electric Meter Crew Foreman will continue to work their regular schedules. This temporary schedule will be in effect from April 1, 1990 through September 30, 1990.

This specific agreement will be in accordance with all provisions of generic Letter Agreement 86-155 except as outlined below.

In order to provide full coverage for the Division, the schedule will be staggered:

Three Senior Metermen will work Monday - Thursday 7:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.

Three Senior Metermen will work Tuesday - Friday 7:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.

Employees will be given their preference for their workweek in the order of Service.
