Company will be relocating two Telecommunication Technicians from McMaude Place in Santa Rosa to Ignacio Substation.

In an attempt to minimize disruption the local Company Labor Relations Representative and local Union Business Representative met to discuss the best method to accomplish this action. As a result of this meeting Company identified two volunteers. Selection of the two volunteers was with the approval of all other Telecommunication Technicians located at McMaude Place.

Accordingly, and pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes that the two volunteer Telecommunication Technicians, Mike Burnett and John Nyquist, be relocated to Ignacio Substation.

It is further proposed, however, that these two employees will be considered as headquartered at Ignacio Substation for the purposes of Title 201 and that for all other contract provisions their headquarters will remain McMaude Place.

This agreement will become effective as soon as the move can be made following the signing of this agreement. Either party may cancel this agreement by providing 30 days advance notice.
