Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement and Letter Agreement 86-155-PGE, the Company proposes to establish a temporary four-day, ten-hour workweek schedule for certain Hydro Generation employees headquartered at Auburn and Alta in Central Area Hydro.

This temporary workweek schedule shall be with the following conditions:

- The proposed temporary schedule will be implemented on April 1, 1990 and continue through and including October 28, 1990.
- 2. All Central Area Hydro Generation employees headquartered in Auburn and Alta will be placed on the four-day, ten-hour schedule except for employees in the classifications of Roving Operator, System Operator, Operator-in-Training, Helper (0926) - Operating, Ditch Tender, and Water Facilities Maintenanceman.
- 3. Employees will work a Monday Thursday workweek, and work hours will be from 0700 1730.
- 4. Should paychecks not be available on Thursday, it will be the employees' responsibility to pick up their checks on their own time.
- 5. Either the Company or Union reserves the right to cancel this agreement and return to the regular five-day, eight-hour workweek schedule by giving fifteen days written notice.

This proposal has been reviewed with Ed Fortier, Senior Business Representative.
