Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Title 3.5 of the Physical Agreement, Company and Union propose to waive the residential requirement for Troublemaker James Vaughan provided Mr. Vaughan maintains his residence at 2407 Tuckahoe, Watsonville. Any relocation necessitated by agreement to this waiver would be without reference to Section 206.8 of the Physical Agreement and must be affected by May 1, 1990.

Company further proposes that Mr. Vaughan take his truck home at the end of his workday in order to enable quick response to callout.

Either party reserves the right to cancel this agreement with thirty days written notice.

This proposal has been discussed with the local IBEW Business Representative.
