Pursuant to Subsections 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement and 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to establish a temporary four-day, ten-hour workweek for the Stockton Gas T&D Department. The following employees will work Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.:

All upgrades during the term of this agreement will be made from among those qualified employees on the shift in which the vacancy occurs.

This agreement may be cancelled by either party upon ten days' written notice.
