Gentlemen:

Company proposes that the parties enter into agreement for the purpose of relocating an employee from the Stockton Gas T&D Department to the Stockton Gas T&R Department. Mr. Charles Edwards, Helper - Gas T&D, has been performing leak survey work on an upgrade to Fieldman in the Gas T&D Department for several months. Leak survey work is also performed by a Field Meterman in the Stockton Gas T&R Department.

The Company desires to consolidate the leak survey function into the Gas T&R Department and have all such work performed by employees holding the same classification. Therefore, another Field Meterman position was created in the Gas T&R Department and awarded pursuant to Section 205.7(a) to Mr. Charles Edwards. This job award returns Mr. Edwards to the headquarters from which he was displaced, and gives him a base pay rate closer to that from which he was demoted (Pressure Operator).

In light of the benefits from this move for both the Company and the employee, the Company proposes that the floor headcount for purposes of Letter Agreement 88-104 be adjusted to reflect this shift in work load. This adjustment would place the Gas T&D Control Number for 4040 West Lane at 40, and the Gas T&D Control Number for 535 S. Center Street at 2.
