Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to formalize the oral agreement of the parties with regard to Combination Crew classifications and lines of progression for incumbents of those classifications. Company proposes, therefore, pursuant to Subsection 204.4(b) of the Physical Agreement, to the following inclusions:

- (1) The 0737 Underground Construction Crew Foreman (Electric) will be placed in all lines of progression where the 0740 Electric Crew Foreman appears.
- (2) The 0738 Underground Construction Crew Foreman (Gas) will be placed in all lines of progression where the 0640 Gas Crew Foreman (Welding) appears.
- (3) The 1077 Underground Construction Journeyman (Electric) will be placed in all lines of progression where the 1100 Lineman appears.
- (4) The 1078 Underground Construction Journeyman (Gas) will be placed in all lines of progression where the 0560 Fitter appears.

In addition, in reviewing the line of progression for the Underground Construction Journeyman it appears that the 0640 Gas Crew Foreman (Welding) has been overlooked. Company, therefore, proposes to include the 0640 Gas Crew Foreman (Welding) in the Same or Higher Classifications to the Underground Construction Journeyman lines of progression.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
