SYNOPSIS OF CHANGES TO NPAP A-20

4.0 Added a new definition to this section:

Ξ.

4.1.15 <u>"Licensed Operators"</u> are holders of a license pursuant to 10CFR55 and who manipulate the controls or directs others to manipulate the controls of a nuclear power plant.

The numbering on the remaining definitions (currently 4.1.15-4.1.26) will require the addition of one increment.

- 5.2.3 Added the following <u>Note</u> after this section:
 - Note: A licensed operator who is involved in the sale, use, or possession of an illegal drug, either on-duty or off-duty, is also subject to license suspension, revocation, or denial.
- 5.2.6 Added the following <u>Note</u> after this section:
 - Note: In the case of a licensed operator's drug <u>or</u> alcohol failure, the NRC may also issue a notice of violation or a civil penalty <u>or</u> an order to suspend, modify, or revoke the Part 55 license. Generally, in the absence of aggravating circumstances, such as errors in the performance of licensed duties, only a notice of violation will be issued.
- 5.2.7 Added the following <u>Note</u> after this section:

Note: In the case of a licensed operator's second drug <u>or</u> alcohol failure, the NRC will issue an order to suspend the Part 55 license for up to three years.

5.2.8 Added the following statement after this section:

5.2.9 Added the following statement after this section:

5.2.11 Inserted the following statement under this section:

A third confirmed positive test for illegal drugs <u>or</u> alcohol shall result in <u>permanent</u> revocation of DCPP site access.

Note: In the case of a licensed operators', the NRC will issue an order to revoke the Part 55 license.

The numbering on the remaining sections (currently 5.2.11-5.2.14) will require the addition of one increment.

5.2.14 (Previously 5.2.13) Added the following Note after this section:

Note: A licensed operator who refuses to participate, i.e., refuses to provide a specimen for analysis, alters or substitutes a specimen, or fails to report to the collection facility, is also subject to license suspension, revocation, or denial.

5.3.3 Added the following <u>Note</u> after this section:

Note: Specific requirements for the reporting of impairing medications taken by licensed operators is contained in AP A-150.

5.5 Added the following statement at the end of this section:

Specific requirements for supervisors of licensed operators is contained in AP A-150.

- 5.12.1.c Revised this section to read: "...and the role of the Medical Review Officer and the supervisor in reporting use of over-the-counter or prescription drugs;".
- 6.0 Added the following references to this section:

10CFR2, Appendix C, General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions and 10CFR55, Operators' Licenses
