Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 10.4 of the Clerical Agreement, the company proposes to amend the flextime hours for one Utility Clerk-Accounting position in the Accounting Data Control Section, Accounting Services Department, that were established under Letter Agreement No. 90-193-PGE signed by the Union on September 11, 1990.

The flextime band widths for all bargaining unit employees within the Controller's organization are from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Accounting Data Control Section is responsible for distribution of computerized reports to all departments within the Controller's organization. However, certain departments require the reports to be available when employees report to work.

To fulfill this business obligation, the company proposes to ask for volunteers to work augmented flextime hours, i.e., from 5:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. One Utility Clerk-Accounting would meet this need.

All other conditions would remain the same as defined in Letter Agreement No. 90-193-PGE with the exception that this agreement will remain $in\ force$ until such a time as either party gives the other 30 days' notice of cancellation.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the company.
