Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Labor Agreement, the Company proposes to appoint Jeff A. McGrath to a "provisional" Electrician, Midway Substation, San Joaquin Valley Region. Mr. McGrath is currently a journeyman Electrician with General Construction. Mr. McGrath is the only interested bidder to the Midway Electrician position.

Mr. McGrath will be required to take and pass the Substation Maintenance (Relay and Vector) course required to complete the Division Apprentice Electrician training program. This requirement must be met by November 2, 1991 in order to remove his provisional status. Failure to meet the requirement will result in demotion in accordance with Section G of the Master Apprenticeship Agreement.

In the application of Title 206, demotion for lack of work, Mr. McGrath will be considered an Electrician, but will maintain his provisional status.
