Gentlemen:

The general wage settlement effective January 1, 1983 provided that the starting rate for all new hires into beginning level classifications (with the exception of the classifications headquarters at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant) be held at the 1982 starting rate. On the effective date of that agreement, no beginning level classifications existed in the Building Services Department at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP).

On September 1, 1992, the classification of 0927 Utility Worker Building was established in the Building Services Department at DCPP. This classification was filled by new hire.

Because the classification of 0927 Utility Worker Building had not previously existed at DCPP, it provides a lower beginning pay step than that of other Utility Worker classifications headquartered at the Plant. To provide pay equity within the Plant, Company proposes to increase the rate of pay for Utility Worker classification in the Building Services Department at DCPP to equal the rate of other Utility Worker classifications at DCPP. To that end, the following classification and pay rate would be established:
