Gentlemen:

Company proposes to make the following administrative changes to Sections 1.5, 5.2.12, 5.2.13, and 5.7.10 of the Nuclear Plant Administrative Procedure on the Fitness for Duty Program (NPAP A-20).

Add Section 1.5 (current Section 1.5 changed to 1.6)

This program also requires individuals who report on-site more than two (2) days per week to gain and maintain unescorted security access.

Correct a typographical error in Section 5.2.12

Change the word "position" to read "positive".

Add Section 5.2.13 (current Section 5.2.13 changed to 5.2.14)

Resignation prior to removal for violation of NPG's Fitness for Duty Program shall be recorded as removals for cause. IBEW, Local 1245

Add Section 5.7.10 (current Section 5.7.10 changed to 5.7.11)

With the approval of the Fitness for Duty Supervisor, persons with a medical condition which prevents them from providing a urine and/or breath specimen under the conditions outlined in this procedure will be given the option of providing a blood specimen for the purpose of chemical testing. The blood specimen will be analyzed for drug metabolites and/or alcohol concentration consistent with the type of test being conducted (i.e., pre-employment, pre-access, random, for cause, post-accident, and follow-up).
