Gentlemen:

The Union proposes pursuant to Title 202.16b and Letter Agreement 90-52 to incorporate the following shift schedule for the second quarter of 1992 for the Chem & Rad Dept. at Diablo Canyon Power Plant. The second quarter is scheduled to begin on March 27, 1992 and end on June 18, 1992.

This proposal will allow for the C&RP Shift Technician day shift 10&4 positions to be changed to 8&6 positions [eight days on (ten hour days), six days off] with equal numbers on the following workweeks:

Work hours and benefits will be in accordance with those defined for day shift employees under Letter Agreement 90-152 except for those exceptions outlined in this proposal.

The hours of work will be from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Relief Technicians will work their normal shifts. If a Relief Technician is required to cover a day shift vacancy the shift worked will be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Workweek selection will be by seniority in each discipline.

The trial period for this schedule will be for the second shift selection quarter of 1992, however, by agreement at the local level between the parties, this agreement may be extended.


