Gentlemen:

The job description for Utility Plant Clerk provides that an employee "may be required to type with reasonable speed (35 words per minute net)." Presently, there are two Utility Plant Clerk jobs at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant whose sole responsibility is to sort and deliver the mail. Because the duties of these jobs do not include typing, the Company proposes to waive the typing test requirement.

If agreed to, the employees filling these two jobs will be required to meet the typing test requirement prior to transferring to other clerical jobs which require typing, including other Utility Plant Clerk jobs.
