Gentlemen:

Recently, it was brought to our attention that a Utility Worker in the Emeryville Electric and Utility group, upon being awarded a 2135 Transformer Repairman classification, was no longer in the line of progression to the 0481 Apprentice Electrician in the Electric Maintenance line of progression. In reviewing the situation, it was acknowledged that the Utility Workers in the Electric and Machine shops at Emeryville had been placed as next lower in the line of progression to several classifications in the Electric Maintenance Department. It was also noted that the 2140 Transformer Repairman is next lower to the 0481 Apprentice Electrician, while the 2135 Transformer Repairman is not.

As a result of discussions between the Parties, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 204.4, to amend Title 600, Exhibit VI-L, Electric Maintenance Job Definitions and Lines of Progression, to place the 2135 Transformer Repairman next lower in the line of progression to the 0481 Apprentice electrician. While it is recognized that is not the usual practice to

place classifications next lower in the line of progression if they are not in the same department, the Parties agreed that the Electric and Utility group in Materials are limited in their options within that group.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
