Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Sections E5 and 6 of Exhibit C (Meter Reading Agreement), Company proposes to allow the Meter Readers at the centralized Napa Headquarters in Silverado Division to rebid route strings on a six month rotation basis.

In conjunction with the organizational consolidation to Napa, the meter readers have selected new realigned route strings to be effective for the period April 1 through December 31, 1992.

The six month rotation process will begin in 1993. Under this agreement, route string bidding will occur every December and June and will be effective each January 1st and July 1st, correspondingly.

This proposal has the approval of a majority of the affected meter readers.
