Gentlemen:

As a result of Fact Finding Committee Case No. 5104-91-204, East Bay Facilities Grievance No. MIS-91-36, this letter agreement has been generated by the Local Investigating Committee.

The Gas Meter Plant currently has a contract with ARC (Association of Retarded Citizens) to clean handhole covers and attach numbers to index boxes on gas meters. This work amounts to approximately 400 manhours per year. The Local Investigating Committee agreed that this work will not be considered a violation of Letter Agreement 88-104 as long as the amount of work being done is not increased.

This agreement may be canceled upon 30 days written notice by either party.
