Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 204.4(b) and Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to reclassify a Measurement and Control Mechanic to a Gas Control Technician at the Sacramento Division office, 5555 Florin-Perkins Road. Operation and maintenance work associated with the new Gas SCADA System, new Electronic Measurement Systems and the equipment associated with the Therm Billing System, require the higher classification because of the more technical nature of this work. In addition, this work now involves computer systems and avanced electronic system.

There are currently eight M&C Mechanics at this headquarters. Company proposes to reclassify the M&C Mechanic, Jerry Robertson, service date March 30, 1966, to a Gas Control Technician position without regard to Subsection 205.4 (h) or Section 205.7. More senior M&C Mechanics at the headquarters have indicated that they are not interested in this position at this time.

This proposal has been discussed with Business Representative Wayne Greer.
