Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter agreement dated March 16, 1973 on the same subject.

In order to provide more logical lines of progression, Company proposes to transfer, effective on a mutually acceptable date, certain classifications between the ESC and IBEW physical bargaining units. The proposed changes include the transfer of the Rodman-Chainman classification presently in the IBEW bargaining unit into the bargaining unit represented by the ESC and the concurrent transfer of the Gas Instrument Technician and the Technical Clerk classifications from the ESC unit to the IBEW physical bargaining unit.

Company further proposes that such transfers be subject to the following conditions:

1. Employees currently classified as Gas Instrument Technician shall be reclassified to the Gas Measurement and Control Mechanic classification provided that such employee has successfully passed the tertiary school provided for in the Apprentice Measurement and Control Mechanic training program. Any Gas Instrument Technician who on April 1, 1973 has not passed the tertiary school shall be placed into the Orifice Meterman classification until such time as he has successfully completed the tertiary training, at which time he shall be reclassified to Measurement and Control Mechanic.
