To reflect changes made in working assignments to the classification of Inspector in the Division Electric Meter Department, Company proposes to revise the Job Definition on Page 12a, Exhibit VI-L, and wage rate as follows:

INSPECTOR

An employee who is engaged in various investigations, such as current diversion, lost meters, obtaining information for setting up charges and similar items. Preinspects meter sets for conformance to Company and governmental requirements and, where required, obtains advance permission for installation of temporary meters.

Present wage rate - \$150.95 per week

Proposed wage rate - \$160.35 per week

Company further proposes that the revised wage rate will be applicable the date agreement is reached on this matter between Company and Union.
