The Company currently administers seperate entrance examinations for the Electrical Technician Apprentice Program for Title 200 and 300 employees. Due to similarities in training programs, Company proposes to combine the Title 200 and 300 entrance examinations into one test.

Company proposes to establish a joint committee of 3 Company members and 3 Union members to review the material currently included in both tests and combine the most relevant material into one test. Labor costs for Union committee members will be paid for by the Company during committee meetings.
