We are in receipt of your letter dated February 22, 1994 which served notice of the cancellation of Letter Agreement R2-92-141-PGE. We are presently taking steps to prepare for the cancellation of the Agreement.

A refueling outage is scheduled to begin March 12, 1994. It would be very difficult to eliminate the use of Labor Janitors during this period of time. For that reason, we request that we be allowed to continue their use through the end of the outage. This will not, however, affect job options which may become available under Title 206 of the Agreement.
