During the initial negotiations on the Rubber Glove Agreement, the parties agreed to review the frequency of dielectric testing of digger derrick booms after one year. Company and Union members of the Rubber Glove Committee have discussed this issue and are jointly recommending that paragraph 9 of the Work Procedures Section of the Rubber Glove Manual be amended to reflect that digger derrick booms continue to be inspected every 6 months.
