Gentlemen:

Company proposes to modify the Title 300 Apprentice Electrical Technician Training Program by immediately deleting the substation maintenance course. This course is currently included in the Title 300 Apprentice Electrical Technician Training Program and the Title 200 Apprentice Electrician Training Program, but over the last several years has become more applicable for the Electrician classification and less applicable to the Electrical Technician classification.

Company proposes to replace the substation maintenance course with a course called Relays and Phasers I. This course would cover current transformers, potential transformers, basic relays, and differential relay schemes. The current Advanced Relays and Vectors course would be renamed Relays and Phasers II.

Once course materials for Relays and Phasers I is developed, it will be submitted to the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee for review and approval. It is expected that this will occur within six months of the signing of this agreement.
