## Gentlemen:

Company proposes to establish a Joint Company-Union Committee to review the current apprenticeship programs for Title 200 and 300 Apprentice Linemen. This committee will review required academic training: the possible conversion of the apprentice programs to performance based training, and the possible consolidation of the Title 200 and 300 programs into one training program.

Company proposes that the committee consist of up to six members appointed by the Company and up to six members appointed by the Union. Labor costs for Union committee members will be paid for by the Company during committee meetings.

The joint committee will submit their recommendations for changes in the apprenticeship programs to the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee for approval.
