Gentlemen:

Company proposes to establish a Joint Company-Union Committee to develop the Technical Compressor Mechanic Apprenticeship Program, previously agreed to in LA 93-91-145. The Committee will attempt to use applicable sections of the existing Transmission Mechanic and Gas Control Mechanic Apprenticeship Programs in designing this program.

Company proposes that the committee consist of two members appointed by the Company and two members appointed by the Union. Labor and expense costs for Union committee members will be paid for by the Company during committee meetings.

The joint committee will submit the proposed apprenticeship program to the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee for approval.
