Gentlemen:

Company proposes the following interpretation of Subsection 308.15(d) of the Physical Agreement as it relates to work performed during the 2R6 outage at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant:

Section 308.15(d) defines "day" as a calendar day for the purposes of the 21 Day Rule. During the 2R6 outage, "day" will be defined as 24 hours. Therefore, employees assigned to a shift that overlaps into another calendar day will only be considered to have worked on one day.

Although not required by Title 110 of the Agreement, the Company also proposes to pay employees in Title 300 classifications assigned to the 6:30pm - 4:30am shift an hourly premium equivalent to the third shift premium.

This proposal has been reviewed by the local Business Representative.

Either party may cancel this agreement with 60 days written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
