## Gentlemen:

As part of our ongoing commitment to the health and safety of our employees, the Company is developing a comprehensive ergonomics program for all physical and clerical employees to reduce the risk of injury.

The Company would like to pilot this program in the Materials line of progression and Lineman classification beginning immediately and ending in November 1995.

Company proposes to establish two Ergonomic Committees, one in the Materials line of progression and the other in the Lineman classification. The Company and Union may each appoint up to 4 members to these joint committees. All related expenses incurred by Union Committee members will be paid by the Company. The Joint Committees will provide input to an external consultant that will design the ergonomics training that is provided to employees.
