Gentlemen:

This Letter Agreement provides for a temporary change to the interpretation of Section 308.15(d) of the Physical Agreement for Title 300 employees who are working at Diablo Canyon Power Plant during the 1R7 and 2R7 refueling outages.

Section 308.15(d) defines "day" as a calendar day for the purposes of the 21 Day Rule. During the refueling outage, "day" will be defined as 24 hours. Therefore, employees whose shift overlap into another calendar day will only be considered to have worked on one day.

Although not required by Title 110 of the Agreement, the Company also proposes to pay employees on the 6:00 p.m. - 4:30 a.m. shift an hourly premium equivalent to the third shift premium.

This proposal has been reviewed by the local Business Representative. Either party may cancel this agreement with 60 days written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
