Gentlemen:

Humboldt Bay Power Plant has occasional need to hire additional radiation protection specialists. Because of the specialized nature of this work, it is sometime difficult to attract workers for short term work assignments without the payment of per diem and reimbursement for travel expenses. Therefore, Company proposes to hire radiation protection specialists as temporary additional employees, under Section 106.12 of the Physical Agreement, as necessary and pay the following per diem and travel as follows:

Per Diem: \$65.75 per day provided that the employee meets the IRS per diem requirements.

Travel: two way travel to Humboldt Bay Power Plant from the employee's point of origin as follows:

Distance	Reimbursement
< 75 miles	\$ 0
75 to 200 miles	60
201 to 500 miles	125
501 to 750 miles	250
751 to 1000 miles	350
>1000 miles	500

This agreement may be canceled by either party with at least 30 days written notice. The local IBEW Business Representative will be notified prior to exercising this Letter of Agreement.
