Gentlemen:

Company proposes to establish a joint committee to review the Gas Supply Coordinator classification (Gas T&S LOP) and Region Gas Control Operator classification (Gas M&C LOP) and the feasibility of establishing a combined Gas System Operator classification and associated training program.

The establishment of this committee is related to the Gas Load Center/Terminal Consolidation Project which began in November 1993. At that time, six gas load centers and four pipeline terminals were operating within the PG&E system. The initial phase completed in July 1994 consolidated the Kettleman terminal into Milpitas and the Santa Rosa gas load center into Sacramento. Phase 2, which was completed in September 1994, consolidated gas load centers in San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose-Cinnabar into the new load center at 111 Almaden in San Jose. The Fresno load center was also consolidated into Sacramento during this phase. Phase 3, which was completed in June 1995, closed the Antioch terminal and consolidated operations into the Brentwood terminal.

Company proposes that this committee include up to 4 members appointed by the Union and up to 4 members appointed by the Company. Company committee members will include representatives from the CES and GSBV Business Units.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
