## Gentlemen:

Company has currently issued three notices of Layoff to Title 300 employees. These employees were not physically qualified to fill Utility Workers vacancies in another General Construction Department. The only option available to them was Section 306.7, Layoff.

Company proposes, due to the small number of employees, to modify the provisions of Letter Agreement 95-30. This modification will be a one time exception to item 2 of that Letter Agreement.

The Company proposes to provide a list of entry level clerical vacancies to the impacted employees for them to indicate the preference and return to the Centralized Job Bidding Team within five days. If more than one impacted employee selects the same job, seniority will determine the award. During this selection and award process the job bidding team will continue to fill positions contingent on these employees' selections.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
