Dear Mr. McNally:

On April 3, 1995, Company and Union executed Letter Agreement 95-15 to establish a Joint Company-Union Committee to review the Apprentice Control Technician Training Program.

Company is now proposing that jointly recommended curriculum changes, including new courses and on the job training, be implemented on an interim basis and communicated as the proposed requirements for the Apprentice Control Technician. These new interim courses and OJT requirements will be in place until a complete review of the training program is completed and approved by the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee.

During this interim period, employees who fail a newly developed section of the training program will be reviewed on an individual case basis by the JATC. In the event that the JATC cannot resolve issues of those who fail, the employee will be subject to the requirements of the old Apprentice Control Technician program.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
