Gentlemen:

During March 1995 the Company, in conjunction with the Union, arranged job interviews for Electric T&D personnel at the Livermore Service Center with Portland General Electric and Union Electric of St. Louis. Employees who were interviewed invested considerable time and effort in preparing for and participating in interviews, as well as in some cases traveling to Oregon and St. Louis.

We are aware of several job offers which have been made as a direct result of the Company and Union arranged interviews. Employees have requested the Voluntary Severance, Application II, if they accept the offer. Given the circumstances under which the interviews were arranged, Company proposes that the Voluntary Severance, Application II, be provided to employees who were interviewed at the Livermore Service Center, received jobs offers from Portland General Electric or Union Electric, and who accept those offers by June 30, 1995 and resign from the Company.
