Dear Mr. McNally:

The Humboldt Bay Power Plant will begin minor maintenance and grounds work on its nuclear unit beginning July 7. This work will require radiation protection monitoring and control beyond what can reasonably be accomplished by Radiation and Process Monitors assigned to Humboldt Bay Power Plant.

Company intends to hire up to two radiation protection specialists as temporary additional employees, under Section 106.12 of the Physical Agreement, to assist in this work. Pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Agreement, Company proposes to establish the following classification to perform this work:

0023 Sr. RP Technician 764.80 to 825.35 \*

\* Wage step based on qualifications and work experience

Additionally, employees will receive a Per Diem payment of \$65.75 per day if the employee meets the IRS Per Diem requirements.

Also, employees in these classifications will be reimbursed for two-way travel to Humboldt Bay Power Plant from the employees point of origin as follows:
