Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 206.12 and Section VII. B. of Volume 1 of 1 of the Title 206 clarification dated January 23, 1995, Company proposes to allow Martin Ericson, Machinist, West Geysers, to accept Application II Severance in lieu of a more junior machinist, Tom Curreri, Geysers-Overhaul who received a Title 206 assignment to Diablo Canyon Power Plant. Company further proposes that Mr. Curreri be assigned to the West Geysers as a Machinist under Section 205.19.

Mr. Ericson was not included in the Title 206 activity. He has requested layoff.

Mr. Curreri has requested to remain at the Geysers and is willing to forego his Title 206 assignment.

This proposal has been discussed with Messrs. Ericson and Curreri and Business Representative Bob Choate.




