Gentlemen:

Recent changes in California State law requires all water treatment plant operators to be certified by the State Department of Public Health rather than the American Water Works Association.

Accordingly, Company proposes to update the job definitions of the Water Treatment Operator classifications as shown below to reflect the certificate these positions now require and to reflect this change in Exhibit VI-G, "Division Water Departments."

1897 WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR - SCHEDULE I

An employee who operates one or more full treatment water plants of two to five million gallons per day capacity. He operates all equipment, including pumps, filters, and controls; runs all laboratory control tests, except bacteriological, collects bacteriological samples, maintains plant records, performs minor maintenance duties and keeps buildings, grounds and equipment in a clean and orderly manner. He is required to have a Waterworks Operator's Certificate, Grade II. Since this work may not require his full time services, he may also be required to work as a Water Serviceman.
