Gentlemen:

Company has expressed an urgent need for temporary Senior Control Operators (SCOs) at Humboldt Bay Power Plant. Three SCOs will be attending the Certified Fuel Handlers training class that begins in February of 1997 and ends April 30, 1997. This training is mandatory for operators working at Humboldt Bay Power Plant. The training schedule will create three temporary vacancies and the current manpower in Operations is unable to cover these vacancies.

The Union proposed to have Company seek temporary SCOs from the Hiring Hall in accordance with Letter of Agreement R1-95-145-PGE, except that in this case, the use of these temporary classifications will not be considered as contracting under Section 207.2 of the Agreement. In order to assure the hiring hall SCOs will have sufficient knowledge to perform the work at the plant, they need to commence work on January 20, 1997. This will provide them with a two week familiarization period before the training classes begin on February 1, 1997. This agreement will expire on April 30, 1997.
