Dear Mr. McNally:

Due to the large number of Apprentice Lineman positions that Company is filling and the fact that many of the candidates have not attended the 3-day Division or General Construction Climbing School, Company proposes to temporarily combine the 3-day Climbing School and 10-day Basic Climbing School into a 10-Day Climbing School held at the Livermore Training Center.

Company's proposal would only impact those employees who have not yet attended the 3-day climbing school. This proposal would be limited to six months from the signing of this agreement.

This proposal has been discussed with Sr. Business Representative Landis Marttila.
