Gentlemen:

Due to low call volume during the summer months in the Company's four Call Centers, the Company has more CSR-scheduled work hours than call volume warrants. The Company has very successfully sought volunteers to work in division offices and has also offered employees time off without pay in accordance with the provisions of Letter Agreement 95-82.

Company is also proposing to offer interested Call Center employees with regular status an opportunity to take an unpaid leave of absence for other than an urgent or substantial personal reason (Leave of Absence-Call Center) for up to 3 months. Each Call Center would determine its ability to offer leaves of absence by classification, and based on its ability to grant leaves, would consider volunteers by classification in order of seniority at that center.

The provisions of this agreement are limited to Call Center employees through October 1, 1996.

Employee benefits during this leave of absence will be treated like a regular personal leave of absence.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
