Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7.15 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to place Robert Fisher into a vacant Meter Reader position in the Santa Cruz Customer Field Services Department.

Mr. Fisher has been on extended medical leave and has been receiving Long Term Disability benefits for approximately two years. He has been precluded from returning to his former classification as a Utility Worker. Mr. Fisher's personal physician and a Company panel physician have released him to return to work without restriction to the Meter Reader classification.

Mr. Fisher's new wage rate will be determined in accordance with Subsection 13.9 (c).

This proposal has been discussed with Ed Caruso, IBEW Business Representative and is without precedent.
