Gentlemen:

Company proposes to modify Paragraph G(10)(c) of the Division Master Apprenticeship Agreement as noted below.

c. An employee hired into an apprentice classification where there are no qualified bidders, or an employee who enters an apprentice classification from a different line of progression will be required to spend one year in such apprenticeship at the beginning wage rate for such classification. The first six months of such year will be used by Company to familiarize the employee with the associated tools, equipment, and procedures of that department.

Employees bidding an apprentice classification from a different line of progression, but who previously spent at least one year during the past five years in the same line of progression as the apprentice position, will be exempt from the above requirement to spend one year at the beginning wage rate. (added language)

This proposal has been discussed with Senior Business Representative Landis Marttila.
