Gentlemen:

In accordance to 204.4(b) of the Physical Agreement between Company and IBEW Local Union 1245, Kern Division proposes to establish an additional position at the Bakersfield Service Center within Gas T&D. Company proposes to establish this position as a Utility Field Clerk Bakersfield with a single rate of pay of \$854.20 per week.

The description of this position will read as follows:

An employee whose background and experience are such that he has working knowledge of the Gas T&D Department and performs field and office clerical functions for the General Foreman and crews. May be required to order and keep inventory of Gas T&D materials and supplies. May be required to deliver material for jobs, i.e. plastic pipe, risers, valves and related fittings and hazardous waste related items. May be required to operate a fork lift, to perform construction job pre-checks, and investigate customer complaints. May be required to operate a computer for inputting payroll information and performs cost tracking.

Position will be a part of the normal line of progression of Gas T&D. Position will be considered the same or higher as Fieldman and Apprentice Fitter but will not be considered next lower to Equipment Operator.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
