Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 18.15 and Letter of Agreement No. R1-91-99-PG&E, Company proposes to place David DiLuzio, a Customer Service Representative in the San Francisco Call Center into a Meter Reader position in the Customer Services Department in Belmont. This proposal would supersede Letter Agreement 95-146 in that it is allowing placement into a regular Meter Reader position other than via a transfer by a current Meter Reader.

Mr. DiLuzio has met the criteria outlined in Letter Agreement R1-91-99-PG&E and has passed the Meter Reader Test Battery. He has a medical condition that precludes him from working in his normal classification of Customer Service Representative. He does not qualify for a physical position as he has taken the physical test battery and failed to qualify.

This proposal has been discussed with Business Representatives Eric Wolfe and Hunter Stern.
