Pursuant to Section 19.12 of the Clerical Agreement and in conjunction with the clerical displacements expected to occur in May 1997, the Company proposes that prior to providing impacted employees Section 19.2 notification and displacement options, the Company will allow Utility Clerks-Accounting to exercise Section 19.9 "a" rights to Utility Machine Operator vacancies in West Sacramento. Employees exercising such rights will be eligible for the \$2,000 special allowance.
