Gentlemen:

Letter of Agreement 89-209 established a 12 hour alternate shift schedule for the Operations Department at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant. Section 11, Special Projects, of that agreement allows the assignment of up to two employees per watch to a different shift schedule for special projects.

Company proposes to amend this agreement to allow the option of designating one employee assigned to the Rad Waste Operator Special Project, pursuant to Section 11, as a relief shift employee. Such employee will be responsible for the relief of employees assigned to the Rad Waste Operator Special Project. This employee will be selected based on seniority and the assignment is voluntary. The employee will receive the Relief Operator premium during the time of the special project assignment.

This agreement can be canceled by either party within 30 days advance written notice.
