Dear Mr. McNally:

Pursuant to Subsection 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to modify Letter Agreement 93-97, and establish a 9-80 work schedule for the Peninsula Division Customer Services Department in Belmont which includes the option of a non-scheduled day occurring in the middle of a workweek. Employees on the 9-80 schedule will have the option to volunteer to take their non-scheduled work day mid-week instead of in conjunction with their non-work days or weekend.

An employee's schedule may include a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday as a non-scheduled day. Consistent with LA 93-97 the non-scheduled day off will be the same day every other week. All other provisions of the Letter Agreement will be observed.

This proposal has been discussed with Business Representative Hunter Stern. Either party may cancel this agreement by giving 30 days written notice.
