Dear Mr. McNally:

Due to low call volume during the spring and summer months in the Company's four Call Centers, the Company has more CSR-scheduled work hours than call volume warrants. In previous years, the Company has been successful in seeking volunteers to work in local offices and has also offered time off without pay (T time), in accordance with the provisions of Letter Agreement 95-82.

Company is also proposing to offer interested Call Center employees with regular status an opportunity to take an unpaid leave of absence for other than urgent or substantial personal reasons (Leave of Absence-Call Center) for up to seven months through October 31, 1998. The Company will retain the right to grant leaves of absence based on staffing levels and projected call volume. Each Call Center will determine its ability to offer leaves of absence by classification and will consider volunteers by classification in order of seniority at that center.

Employee benefits during this leave of absence will be treated like a regular personal leave of absence.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
